



FNGLA's Landscape Certifications

Instructions to set up students for Landscape Certification

FNGLA's Certified Landscape Technician (FCLT-Installation) and Maintenance Technician (FCLMT) are both CAPE approved for Florida's high school students.

1. Request free Study Guide from FNGLA and purchase either the *FNGLA Landscape Installation Manual* or the *FNGLA Landscape Maintenance Manual*, depending on which exam you plan to have your students take.
2. Contact FNGLA's Certification Department to set the date testing will be scheduled. Because FNGLA's landscape and irrigation exams are hands-on, practical exams, we will establish where the exam will take place – whether at the school, at the FNGLA office, or at another location.
3. Provide FNGLA the students' names, home addresses and their school-issued email addresses.
4. Once a date and location have been set and FNGLA has received the list of students to test, FNGLA will secure certified judges for the exam and will coordinate with the instructor on any equipment and supply needs.
5. On the day of the exam, FNGLA and the instructor will check in the students who are testing, provide their schedule for the day and introduce them to the certified judges.
6. When the testing begins, the instructor will leave the testing area and the certified judges will conduct the exam, which takes approximately four and a half hours to complete.
7. Within the week, it is our goal to provide the instructor with a report of the results of each student's exams.
8. The Florida Department of Education requires a 20-day waiting period between retesting any failed section of the exam. Retests will be scheduled as needed.
